Nicene Creed





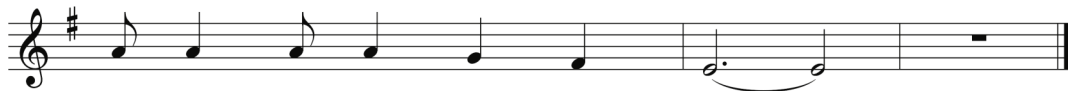
