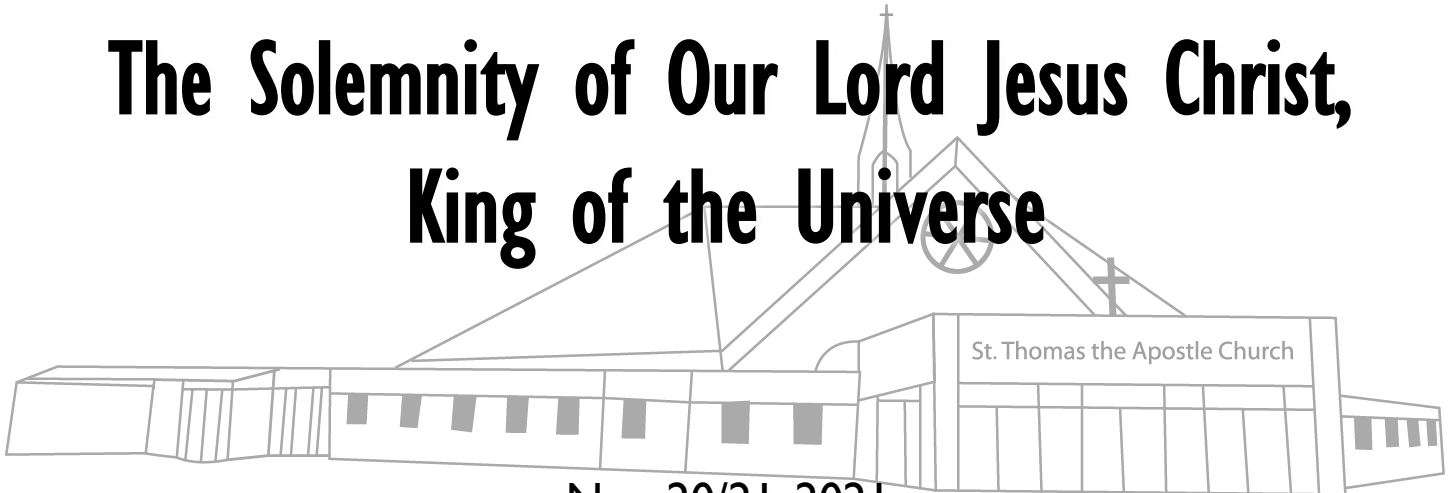

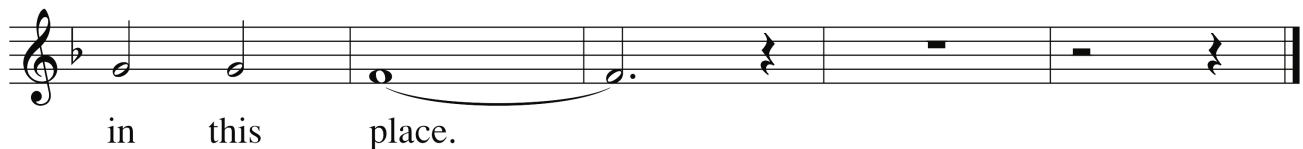



Profession of Faith

Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

Bought with the precious blood of Christ.






