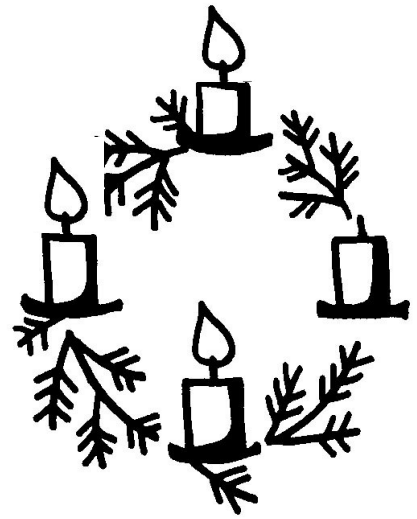

Nicene Creed




