


SACRISTAN

- Beginning in Vesting Sacristy, review Presider / Deacon — Determines which chalice/paten set
 - ⇒ Fr. Joseph Kappilumakkal = gold chalice and paten, with liturgically correct chalice pall
 - ⇒ Fr. Philip Danaher, visiting priests = silver chalice and paten
 - Place chalice, paten (filled with large, presider host from fridge), tabernacle key, sacred vessel key, and water glass(es) on black, plastic tray to bring to Working Sacristy
 - In Working Sacristy, prepare Credence Tray; place on Credence Table
 - ⇒ hand towel
 - ⇒ lavabo (bowl) with water
 - ⇒ Cruet (small pitcher) containing water
 - ⇒ Presider's chalice
 - ⇒ purificator for Presider's chalice

- Prepare hosts for consecration:
 - 1) Bring ciboria with consecrated hosts from tabernacle to Working Sacristy. Distribute approx. 30 Eucharist into additional ciboria as needed. Place these ciboria on a tray on the preparation table outside the sacristy door (behind BVM statue) with a purificator on top. The EM Captain will bring these ciboria to the altar during the Lamb of God.
 - ⇒ Saturday, 4:30 PM — place one ciboria back in Tabernacle for Outdoor Communion Minister
 - 2) Taking into account how many ciboria with consecrated hosts are on the preparation table, prepare more ciboria for consecration:
 - ◇ Saturday, 4:30 PM — 8 total ciboria, approx. 40 hosts in each ciboria
 - ◇ Sunday, 9:00 AM — 9 total ciboria, approx. 40 hosts in each ciboria
 - ◇ Sunday, 10:45 AM — 7 total ciboria, approx. 40 hosts in each ciboria
 - 3) Bring tray with ciboria containing hosts (NOT consecrated) to gift table
 - Bring small flagon (pitcher) with wine for presider and paten with large host to Gift Table. Ensure blue paten (for Low-Gluten pyxes) is also on table, and any pyxes contain hosts.
 - Put water cups on side tables by presider chairs
 - Light altar and ambo candles

Preparations for Mass are now complete.

At the end of Mass, please clean and put away all things you set up; leaving altar and both sacristies as neat as when you arrived.
