



Year 2 – High School Youth Ministry & Faith Formation 2025-2026

Greetings High School Parents and Teens of **Year 2 Confirmation Preparation!** **Registration is now online.** We are excited to begin the 2nd year of preparation for Confirmation! This is a year to dig deeper, not only into the Catholic faith, but also to grow your spiritual relationship with God. Here are a few important pieces to the Confirmation preparation:

- **LIFE Retreat – Dates will be forthcoming.**

An important part of the second-year experience is participation in the LIFE retreat here at St. Thomas. **It is essential that the teens participate for the entire retreat as the schedule is packed with activities in a particular progression.** The retreat will start Friday evening with an overnight at the parish (Fri only) and end Sunday with the 11:15 Mass. There will be **no** overnight on Saturday night. Parents will pick up youth Saturday night at 10:00pm and return youth at 9:00am Sunday morning. More retreat information to come. Parents are invited to the closing Mass.

- **Confirmation Classes**

There is a series of eight 75 minute classes at St. Thomas for the Confirmation Candidates to attend. See registration for class times. Specific dates will be forthcoming and you will be notified of dates once we have enough small group leaders. The sessions will begin either mid-September or the beginning of October, depending on volunteers availability to lead classes. Call Dorothy for homeschooling information if needed. We are anticipating an April or May date for Confirmation.

- **Journey Nights**

Journey Nights are large group gatherings where students and parents come together to listen to a speaker 2-3 times a year. **Journey night dates are TBD.**

- **Service Volunteer Hours**

Confirmation Candidates are expected to complete 10 service hours for this year. If your youth has not turned in last's year's reflection and log of the 20 hours required from last year, please have them do so as soon as you can. You can print the explanation of service hour requirement and the forms to log and reflect on the service at www.stapostle.org, then click on Religious Education/HighSchool/Confirmation Program.

- **Saint Report, Prayer Experiences and Faith Action Plan**

Confirmation Candidates will receive a red folder with a dove on it that will include all the forms and work that needs to be turned in. They will receive this at the first Journey night.

If you have not registered, please do the following:

- Register online. The link can be found on the parish website.
- **Submit full tuition payments.** Payments can be made online or by check or cash. If not paying online, tuition can be dropped off at the RE Office or in the outdoor drop box located outside the Gathering Area doors (Door A).
- Registration & Tuition deadline is July 1, 2025.

1. Create your Family Profile via [REGISTRATION LINK](#) or the **QR code**

Must Include:

- Your email and cell number are for St. Thomas RE use only.
- Children’s Medical Insurance Information
- Children’s Family Physician Name & Phone Number
- 2 Emergency Contacts for your child(ren). *These must be other than a parent.*
- Receipt of Joliet Diocese Policies found here (select yes for each one):

- This information only needs to be entered once, in your profile, and will then be on file for your whole family. **Your registration will not be considered complete without this information.**



2. Add your spouse if applicable. Include email and cell number for RE communications.
3. Add only your children who will be participating in PreK – 8th grade RE.
4. When you have all your children and hit ‘No’ when asked if there are any more children, you will be taken to a closing message. Choose the PreK-8th Registration link.
5. Click on the Grade Level.
6. Choose the child for this grade.
7. Repeat for each child you are registering.
8. Your child’s name will appear in a green box for the grade in which they have been registered.
9. Once done registering all of your children, close this tab and you will see a confirmation of registration.
10. You will receive an email from mail@flocknote.com to confirm your signup. Please file this email for future reference.
11. Tuition Payment
 - 1 Teen = \$240 2 Teens = \$420
